



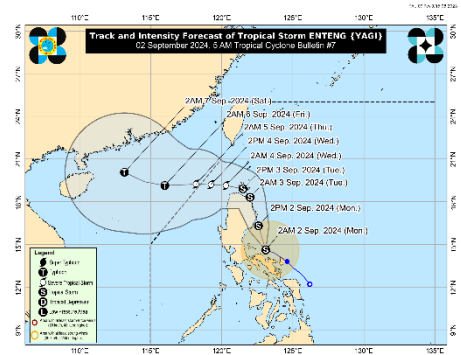

TROPICAL DEPRESSION ENTENG
 September 2, 2024, 9:00 AM

I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A Low Pressure Area developed into Tropical Depression [TD] on September 1, 2024 that was moving northwestward at 10 kilometers per hour. The TD brought maximum sustained winds of 75 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 90 km/h. Strong to gale-force winds extend outwards up to 250 km from the center, heavy rainfall [ORANGE WARNING] and rough seas was experienced in the province. Public Storm Warning Signal No. 1 is still in effect over Albay.
