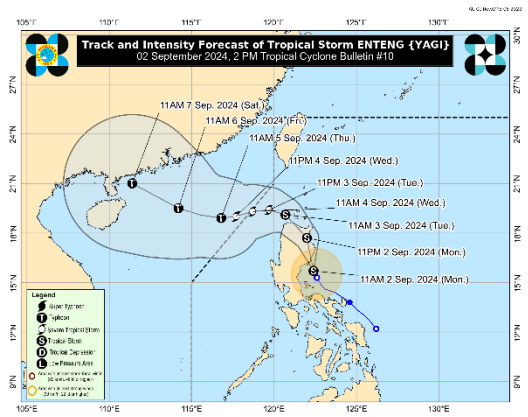
SITUATIONAL – ACTIVITY - MONITORING REPORT

TROPICAL DEPRESSION ENTENG
 September 2, 2024, 5:00 PM

I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A Low Pressure Area developed into Tropical Depression [TD] on September 1, 2024 that was moving northwestward at 10 kilometers per hour. The TD brought maximum sustained winds of 75 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 90 km/h. Strong to gale-force winds extend outwards up to 250 km from the center, heavy rainfall [ORANGE WARNING] and rough seas was experienced in the province. Public Storm Warning Signal [PSWS] No. 1 was raised over Albay.

At 2:00 PM, September 2, 2024, TD Enteng was observed by PAGASA to be in the vicinity of Casiguran Aurora with maximum sustained winds of 85 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 105 km/h. TD Enteng continues to move North northwestward at 20 km/h. currently, no PSWS is present in Albay.
