## SITUATIONAL – ACTIVITY - MONITORING REPORT

**TYPHOON PEPITO 1**  
November 15, 2024, 9:00 PM

### I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Typhoon Pepito entered the PAR on November 14, 2024 and is currently 465 kilometers East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar [11.1 °N, 130.0 °E]; Pepito is moving West Northwestward at 30 kph with maximum sustained winds of 150 kph near the center. Albay is under TCWS No. 1.

As part of the preparedness measure, Albay PDRRC-APSEMO issued advisories 27 placing the entire province under the state of readiness and subsequent advisories 28, 29 and 30, directing concerned agencies and the public of specific instructions to mitigate the impacts of Pepito to include work and class suspension. Evacuation had been ordered on November 15, 2024 to be completed before 5:00 PM of the same day.
