PREPAREDNESS AND MONITORING STATUS – TS MAN-YI [PEPITO]

November 13, 2024 3:00 PM

Tropical Storm Man-Yi [Pepito] was located by PAGASA to be 1,965 kilometers east of Eastern Visayas and is expected to enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility [PAR] tomorrow, November 14, 2024. PAGASA's forecast expects TS Man-Yi [Pepito] to cross Albay, particularly the eastern portion of the province.

Due to the impending threats anticipated from the above weather disturbance, the Albay PDRRMC-APSEMO informs all City/Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices of the following directives:

- 1. **Preparedness and Monitoring Status:** All offices are to be in PREPAREDNESS AND MONITORING STATUS effective today, November 13, 2024.
- 2. **Prepositioning of Equipment and Resources:** Preposition equipment and other necessary resources to respond to the effects of TS Man-Yi [Pepito].
- 3. Activation of Task Units: Activate the Task Units of the respective BDRRMCs in your jurisdiction.

Similarly, all members of the Albay PDRRMC, particularly the following:

- Provincial Health Office
- Provincial Engineering Office
- Provincial Social Welfare Office
- Albay Police Provincial Office -PNP
- Department of Education
- Philippine Army
- Philippine Navy
- DPWH District Engineering Offices
- Philippine Coast Guard

are requested to muster all available resources and facilities needed for possible deployment during our pre-emptive activities to mitigate the impacts of TS Man-Yi [Pepito].
