LENTEN WEEK ADVISORY

April 10, 2025, 10:00 AM

In anticipation of the observance of Holy Week from April 14 to 20, 2025, the Albay PDRRMC hereby issues the following guidelines and reminders to all LGUs and the general public:

To all City/Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices and BDRRMC's:

1. Review and/or establish a contingency plan in relation to the weeklong religious activities. Coordinate with necessary agencies to prepare and maintain 24-hour operational readiness to respond to any untoward incidents.
2. Ensure availability of ambulances and personnel 24/7.
3. Monitor roads and major thoroughfares and provide assistance as needed.
4. Maintain close monitoring of beaches (both private and public), particularly resorts and hotels offering water recreational activities. Ensure that safety measures, such as lifeguards, first aid providers, and medical supplies are present and available.
5. To streamline emergency responses and simplify contact information for the public, publish and use the mobile number **0947 570 0332** as the universal safety contact number for ambulance, fire, and police assistance across Albay.

To operators of beaches, resorts/hotels, and water recreation activities:


1. Both private and public operators must implement safety measures and exercise due diligence in providing any form of outdoor or water-related activities.
2. Ensure the presence of lifeguards, first aid providers, and readily available medical supplies.

To the general public:

1. Take necessary preparations and exercise caution when traveling, visiting various areas, and engaging in recreational activities.
2. Take necessary precautions and avoid prolonged exposure to warm environments, as temperatures during this time of year are expected to be above normal.
