X. IMMEDIATE NEEDS

Polangui

1. Food and water for affected population.
2. Remedial measures to landslide-hit areas.
3. Early recovery assistance to affected farmers (seed output, livestock dispersal)
4. Rehabilitation of damaged infrastructures.
5. Shelter and recovery assistance to families affected by flashflood and landslide.
6. Supply of medicines for management and prevention of leptospirosis cases and others.

XI. ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN

APSEMO

1. Released PDRRMC Advisories.
2. Conducted pre-disaster activities and inventories ensuring that mitigation measures are in place to maintain zero casualty and minimize damage to properties.
3. Maintained 24 - hour operation and monitoring.
4. Maintained close coordination and monitoring with PAGASA for the latest weather update.
5. Provided media updates and interviews for public information and instructions.
6. Coordinated with concerned agencies to support response operations to affected areas around Albay.
 - a. Stockpiling of goods and medicines and other logistical resources.
 - b. Through the Provincial Engineering Office sent additional vehicles to augment the Local Government Units, including heavy equipment with fuel and personnel.
 - c. The Provincial Health Office sent medical supplies, hygiene kits and medicine to augment and fortify the stocks of the evacuated hospital.
 - d. Provided generators and fuel to serve as the temporary power sources of the facility.
 - e. Dump trucks were deployed for Libon, Polangui, Oas and Guinobatan.
 - f. Equipment and personnel were utilized for evacuation and road clearing efforts.
 - g. In Camalig a team from the Bureau of Fire Protection and Philippine Coast Guard was dispatched by APSEMO to augment the evacuation efforts of the Local Government Unit particularly in Barangay Cotmon where run-off flooding occurred.
 - h. In Barangay Tinago Purok 6 of Camalig the Provincial Engineering Office dispatched a backhoe as requested by the MDRRMO to remove sand and other materials piling up along the river channel endangering surrounding barangays.
 - i. A team from Philippine Army was deployed to Libon to assist in the response effort of the LGU.
7. Governor Noel E. Rosal, PDRRMC Chair released fifty bags of rice each for all the municipalities and cities in Albay to augment relief efforts of LGUs.
8. The PDRRMC Chairman instructed the Provincial Welfare Officer to expedite assistance to individuals in crisis all over the province; and re-stock and preposition goods as necessary.

PSWDO

1. Submitted evacuation reports to APSEMO.
2. Distributed and coordinated relief support to affected LGUs in Albay.

BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION

1. Deployed the following resources:
 - a. 3 BFP Fire Suppression Personnel
 - b. 2 EMS Personnel
 - c. 1 Firetruck
 - d. 1 Ambulance
2. Conducted rescue operation through its local stations:
 - a. 10 individuals in Barangay Ems Barrio - Legazpi City FS
 - b. Camalig - ongoing
3. Conducted evacuation of 97 families or 262 individuals
