## PREPAREDNESS MEASURES FOR TROPICAL CYCLONE "CRISING" AND ENHANCED SOUTHWEST MONSOON

Based on DOST-PAGASA Weather Advisory No. 7 (5:00 AM, July 17, 2025), Tropical Cyclone "Crising" continues to enhance the Southwest Monsoon, with 50–100 mm rainfall over the Bicol Region including Albay. Rainfall may exceed projections in mountainous areas and may significantly increases the risk of flooding, river swelling, and landslides.

In view of these threats, the PDRRMC-APSEMO hereby issues the following advisories:

#### 1. SUSPENSION OF CLASSES

Classes are suspended in the elementary and high school for both public and private effective 12:00 Noon.

#### 2. NO CROSSING OF SWOLLEN RIVERS

All river crossings (on foot or via vehicle) are prohibited while until flooding subsides.

#### 3. EVACUATION PREPAREDNESS & MONITORING

All municipal and barangay DRRMCs are directed to stay on heightened alert, coordinate closely, and mobilize resources as needed.

#### 4. PUBLIC SAFETY REMINDERS

Avoid unnecessary travel, especially in flood-prone roads or near riverbanks

to remain alert and standby for official updates and further advisories from PAGASA and local authorities.
