HEAVY RAINFALL DUE TO LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) AND SOUTHWEST MONSOON (HABAGAT)

August 21, 2025 8:00 P.M.

Based on the Weather Advisory issued at 5:00 P.M. and Heavy Rainfall Advisory No. 3 from PAGASA Southern Luzon issued at 8:00 PM today where Albay may experience **Heavy Rainfall** today until tomorrow due to Low Pressure Area (LPA) and Southwest Monsoon, the Albay PDRRMC hereby orders the following for disaster avoidance and public safety:

1. SUSPENSION OF FACE TO FACE CLASSES

Face to face classes are suspended tomorrow, August 22, 2025 and shifted to alternative learning modality in all levels for both public and private schools until lifted.

2. NO CROSSING OF SWOLLEN RIVERS

All river crossings (on foot or via vehicle) are prohibited while until flooding subsides.

3. PRE-EMPTIVE EVACUATION

Barangay Masarawag (Puroks 4, 5, 6 and 8) to execute Pre-emptive evacuation tomorrow at 6:00 A.M.

4. PUBLIC SAFETY REMINDERS

All are advised to take precautionary measures against the impacts associated with these hazards which include flash floods, landslides and possible lahar flows.

Avoid unnecessary travel, especially in flood-prone roads or near riverbanks and to remain alert and standby for official updates and further advisories from PAGASA and local authorities.

5. All municipal and barangay DRRMCs are directed to stay on heightened alert, coordinate closely, and mobilize resources as needed.
