I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Tropical Storm **#RamilPH** (FENGSHEN)

RAMIL Decelerates while moving west northwestward over the sea east of Sorsogon NORTHWESTWARD OVER THE SEA EAST OF SORSOGON with maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 80 km/h, and central pressure of 1000 hPa, moving west northeastward at 15 km/h. A Gale Warning is in effect over the eastern seaboard of Southern Luzon. Potential impacts of winds: Minor to moderate threat to life and property
