TROPICAL STORM RAMIL - 02

October 18, 2025, 5:00 PM

I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Tropical Storm #**RamilPH** (FENGSHEN)

Following a brief west southwestward movement, RAMIL is forecast to move generally west northwestward or northwestward. The center of RAMIL may make landfall or pass close to Northern Samar this noon or early afternoon, then over Catanduanes this afternoon or evening. Based on the observed movement of RAMIL, the possibility of landfall over Albay or Sorsogon is increasing. Afterwards, it will continue moving west northwestward passing close or over mainland Bicol Region and Polillo Islands.
