I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Tropical Storm [#RamilPH](#) (FENGSHEN)

Issued at 5:00 AM, 19 October 2025

The center of Tropical Storm RAMIL was estimated based on all available data over the coastal waters of Alabat, Quezon (14.1°N, 122.0°E). With intensity of maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 90 km/h, and central pressure of 998 hPa moving west northwestward at 25 km/hr .
