Tropical Storm [#RamilPH](#) (FENGSHEN)
The center of Tropical Storm RAMIL was estimated based on all available data 350 km West of Sinait, Ilocos Sur (17.5°N, 117.2°E). With intensity of maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 80 km/h, and central pressure of 998 hPa moving west northwestward at 25 km/hr .
