SEVERE TROPICAL STORM UWAN - 01

November 7, 2025 4:00 PM

I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Severe Tropical Storm FUNG-WONG outside the Philippine area of responsibility is now named "Uwan" as wind signals are now hoisted over several areas of the country. The center of Severe Tropical Storm UWAN was estimated based on all available data at 1,175 km East of Eastern Visayas (11.6°N, 136.2°E) with maximum sustained winds of 110 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 135 km/h, and central pressure of 975 hPa. It moves westward at 25 km/h and strong to storm-force winds extend outwards up to 780 km from the center

PREPAREDNESS MEASURES FOR UWAN

November 7, 2025
3:00 PM

Based on DOST-PAGASA Tropical Cyclone Advisory No. 9 issued November 7, 2025, 11:00 AM, the center of Severe Tropical Storm Fung-Wong (UWAN) was estimated based on all available data at 1,315 km East of Eastern Visayas (OUTSIDE PAR) (11.6°N, 137.5°E), with maximum sustained winds of 100 km/h near the center, gustiness of up to 125 km/h, and central pressure of 980 hPa. The storm is moving West northwestward at 20 km/h.

In view of these threats and that the province may be directly affected by the storm, the PDRRMC-APSEMO hereby issues the following for disaster avoidance and public safety:

NO SAILING

No sailing to all types of seacrafts effective upon the release of Sea Travel Advisory from Philippine Coastguard.

NO CROSSING OF SWOLLEN RIVERS

All river crossings (on foot or via vehicle, fishing and swimming are prohibited until the event of flooding subsides.

SUSPENSION OF FACE-TO-FACE CLASSES AND WORK IN GOVERNMENT

1. Face to face classes are suspended until lifted and shifted to alternative learning modality in all levels for both public and private effective tomorrow November 8, 2025.
2. Work in government offices are suspended until lifted except for offices/agencies responsible for basic, vital and health services, preparedness and response duties must continue to remain operational to ensure continuity of essential government functions effective tomorrow November 8, 2025.
3. Non vital government functions despite the declaration of suspension of work may be engaged under approved alternate work arrangements subject to applicable laws, rules and regulations.
4. The suspension of work for private agencies/companies is left to the discretion of their respective heads.

GENERAL PUBLIC

1. For families to secure their houses and do marketing of their household requirement today.
2. All are advised to take precautionary measures against the impacts associated with these hazards which include flash floods, landslides and possible lahar flows.
3. All mass gatherings and outdoor related activities especially those outside the province are suspended and those previously given permits in view of these activities are hereby revoked effective immediately.
4. Avoid unnecessary travel, especially in flood-prone roads or near riverbanks and to remain alert and standby for official updates and further advisories from PAGASA and local authorities.

LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCILS

1. Cancellation and recall of all issued travel orders.
2. Prepositioning of relief and emergency vehicles and other resources for evacuation purposes and other emergency needs for early execution of evacuation movement and the delivery of relief goods and services.
3. Ensure timely conduct of pre disaster risk assessment and the conduct of necessary community preparedness works to ensure maximum protection of lives and properties.
4. Make sure that vulnerable population to flood, flash flood and debris flow, lahar, destructive wind, landslide and storm surge are **evacuated** in **SAFE** evacuation facilities; to start early tomorrow morning, **November 8, 2025, and should be completed by 12:00 noon of the same day.**
5. Maintain disaster operation center activated 24/7 and close coordination with APSEMO for periodic updates.
6. All are directed to stay on heightened alert, coordinate closely, and mobilize resources as needed and standby for official updates and further advisories from PAGASA and local authorities.
