- 3. Information dissemination with Punong Barangay and Chief Tanod on preparedness of residents in vulnerable areas

- 5. Continuous dissemination of Pagasa weather Bulletins through various group Chats as well as social media account for public awareness.
- 6. Coordination with DSWD ML, BFP, PNP, MLGOO, and AFP

MDRRMO – DARAGA

- 1. Continues to monitor the situation.
- 2. The MDRRMO, together with the BFP, PNP, Phil Army and GSO, assisted the barangays with their pre-emptive evacuation.

MDRRMO – MALINAO

- 1. Activated the BDRRMC in all 29 Barangays
- 2. Fisher folks were prohibited to sail their small boats
- 3. Samaritan shelters and other evacuation facilities in the barangay were advised to prepare for possible occupancy if the weather worsened
- 4. Monitored continuously the weather bulletin and updates issued by DOST PAGASA
- 5. Transport the stranded evacuees from Labnig Elementary School, Malinao, Albay to LGU Permanent Evacuation Center.
- 6. Cancellation of Fiesta Activity in Malolos, Malinao, Albay

MDRRMO – TIWI

- 1. Conducted Pre – Disaster Risk Assessment
- 2. 24-7 weather monitoring using PAGASA weather updates and all other available resources
- 3. Activation of Barangay/ Municipal Emergency and Disaster Operations Centers
- 4. Early evacuation of all exposed population from HIGH to VERY HIGH RISK of flooding and landslide
- 5. Regular warning thru Facebook and Info cast
- 6. Continuous monitoring of landslide and flood prone areas
- 7. Issuance of advisories
