APSEMO

1. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
2. Continues monitoring of Mayon Volcano Status with Phivolcs.
3. Provided data to Rappler Media and Kabalikat Bicol on Mayon Volcano Alert Level 3.
4. Attended coordination meeting with OCD5 and BHRMC re: Mayon Volcano unrest
5. Consolidate situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.

PROV'L ENGINEERING OFFICE

1. Standby Dump Truck and manpower at Albay PDOC.

PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE

1. Maintained 24/7 Operation at OpCen at the Provincial Health Office.
2. Continuous monitoring and situation reporting were conducted.
3. Conducted surveillance activities in Malilipot and Camalig as part of the initial assessment in the identified evacuation centers.
4. Distributed Hygiene Kits (360 pails), 33 boxes of soaps and assorted medicines to the identified evacuation centers.
5. Consultation meeting with BHRMC, PDOHO and major private hospitals within Albay.
6. Consultation meeting with the Provincial Department of Health Office and the Department of Health – Center for Development (DOH-CHD).
7. Provincial Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (PESU) conducted surveillance activities in Malilipot and Camalig.
8. Conducted sit-in meeting with the Provincial Health Office RHAS and Nutrition Teams.

PHILIPPINE ARMY

1. Standby Army Truck and manpower at Albay PDOC.

ALBAY PROVINCIAL POLICE OFFICE

1. Continuous coordination with APSEMO and deployed personnel to support security in evacuation centers and choke points within the 6-km radius PDZ.

RED CROSS

1. Coordination with the Provincial Cluster Meeting with DSWD ROV and OCD 5.
2. Coordination with the Provincial Veterinary Office re: Amid evacuation support.
3. Coordination for the establishment of Community Kitchen.

6. Assessment and coordination on bladder installation at San Jose ES (as requested by MDRRMO)

8. Ensured provision of hot meals, welfare assistance, and psychological support for evacuees at the evacuation center.
9. Distributed Face Mask

CDRRMO LEGAZPI

1. Continuous operations at the Emergency Operations Center

2. Disseminated safety precautions, weather bulletins and other related information (e.g Heavy Rainfall Warnings) through the Legazpi City DRRMO's Facebook Page
3. Monitored Tandem Stations (Dita and San Francisco) and AWS for rainfall events page 4
4. Recorded hourly rainfall volume
5. Continuous monitoring of updates from PHIVOLCS and PAGASA through their website and other social media platforms.
6. Monitored CCTV live feed for possible flooding and incidents.
7. Continuous checkpoints to restrict entry to the 6km PDZ c/o Legazpi City Police Station.

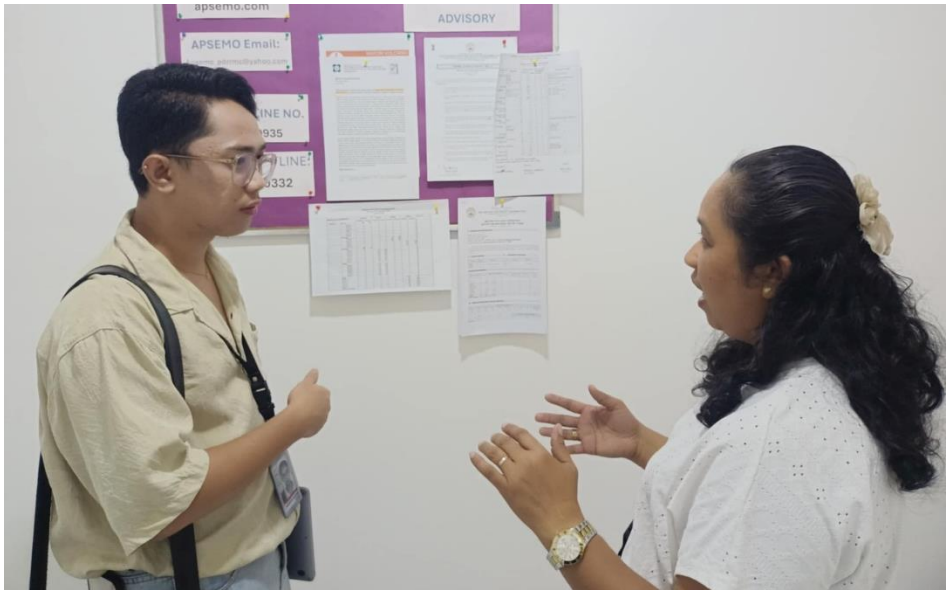
