The Mayon Volcano Lava dome effusion and collapse, incipient lava flow; the crater glow is fair (naked eye), The plume is 800 meters above the crater with moderate emission on a west-southwest and southwest drift and the ground deformation of volcano, edifice is inflated [PHIVOLCS]

### **APSEMO**

1. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring..
2. Continues monitoring of Mayon Volcano Status with Phivolcs.
3. Provided data to Rappler Media and Kabalikat Bicol on Mayon Volcano Alert Level 3.
4. Coordinate with CDRRMO Legazpi regarding available resources for Mayon Volcano Alert Level 3 response activity.
5. Attended Mayon Eruption 2026 Joint-Operation Meeting with OCD5 ,BRHMC, and Liason officers of the provincial response clusters, held at the Albay PDOC.
6. Consolidate situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.

### **PROV'L ENGINEERING OFFICE**

1. Standy Dump Truck and manpower at Albay PDOC.

### **PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE**

1. Maintained 24/7 Operation at OpCen at the Provincial Health Office.
2. Continuous monitoring and situation reporting were conducted.
3. Conducted surveillance activities in Malilipot and Camalig as part of the initial assessment in the identified evacuation centers.

### **ALBAY VETERINARY OFFICE**

1. Coordination meeting with Department of agriculture Regional Field Office 5 and affected CMLGUs.
2. Activation of Provincial Animal Emergency Management Team and Emergency Operation Center
3. Deployed AVO veterinary personnel and coordinated with concerned LGUs and Barangays
4. Conducted surveillance, inspection, and validation of designated animal pooling sites
5. Released advisory to LGU and Barangays to evacuate animal population at risk to the designated animal pooling centers
6. Conducted information dissemination and advisories
7. Preparation of veterinary medical intervention supplies (medicines, vitamins, dewormers, antibiotics, etc.), companion and livestock animal feeds, supplies for feeding camp (drums, sakoline shed, waterer, etc.) and ropes.

### **PHILIPPINE ARMY**

1. Standy Army Truck and manpower at Albay PDOC.

### **ALBAY PROVINCIAL POLICE OFFICE**

1. Continuous coordination with APSEMO and deployed personnel to support security in evacuation centers and choke points within the 6-km radius PDZ.

### **CDRRMO – LIGAO**

1. Continuously updates the barangays on the Mayon volcano status.

### **CDRRMO LEGAZPI**

1. Continuous operations at the Emergency Operations Center
2. Disseminated safety precautions, weather bulletins and other related information (e.g Heavy Rainfall Warnings) through the Legazpi City DRRMO's Facebook Page
3. Monitored Tandem Stations (Dita and San Francisco) and AWS for rainfall events page 4
4. Recorded hourly rainfall volume
5. Continuous monitoring of updates from PHIVOLCS and PAGASA through their website and other social media platforms.
6. Monitored CCTV live feed for possible flooding and incidents.
7. Continuous checkpoints to restrict entry to the 6km PDZ c/o Legazpi City Police Station.
8. Conducted IEC Campaign for Mayon Volcano Preparedness at Barangay Padang, Buyoan,

Matanag, Bogña and Mabinit.

9. Repaired circuit breaker of the solar-powered water pump at PAGCOR Evacuation Center.

1. On blue Alert status and standby alert.


