VIII. ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN

APSEMO

1. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
2. Continues monitoring of Mayon Volcano Status with Phivolcs.
3. Consolidate situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.
4. Maintained Mayon Eruption 2026 Joint Operation Center
5. Conducted Joint operation preparedness plan for emergency operation center extension.

PROV'L ENGINEERING OFFICE

1. Standby Dump Truck and manpower at Albay PDOC.

PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE

1. Maintained 24/7 Operation Center (OpCen) at the Provincial Health Office.
2. Continuous monitoring and situation reporting were conducted.
3. The RHS and Nutrition Team conducted assessment and monitoring activities in the identified evacuation centers in the 1st District of Albay.
4. The Sanitation Team conducted Olyset net distribution and dissemination of IEC materials in Bariw and Tagaytay Camalig, Albay; also in Baligang, Ligao City for public health and sanitation.
5. Provide health information on Facebook page particularly on hazard effects of Mayon Volcanic activity to human health.
6. Distributed hygiene kits to Evacuation Centers.
7. Health Emergency Response Team remains on full alert.

PSWDO

1. Continuous coordination with LSWDOs re: status report.
2. Monitoring and consolidation of submitted evacuation report.
3. Monitoring visit to Evacuation Centers in Ligao City, Guinobatan, Camalig, Malilipot, and Tabaco City.

ALBAY VETERINARY OFFICE

1. Monitoring of Animal Pooling Site at Barangay Budiao and Miisi, Daraga, Albay as well as Dona Tomasa, Guinobatan, Albay.
2. Conducted veterinary medical interventions such as deworming, vitamin supplementation, checkup, and treatment.
3. Distributed Ruminant Feeds (50kg), Feeding Trough/Drums, and Ropes (10 meters).
4. Conducted Ear Tagging & Registration of Animals.
5. Conducted orientation to affected livestock raisers.
6. Continued monitoring of the status of animals at pooling sites.
7. Setup of feeding camps.
8. Coordination with Department of Agriculture Regional Field Office 5 and affected CMLGUs.
9. Deployed AVO veterinary personnel and coordinated with concerned LGUs and Barangays.
10. Ongoing surveillance and inspection of validated animal pooling sites.
11. Prepared veterinary medical intervention supplies (medicines, vitamins, dewormers, antibiotics, etc.), companion and livestock animal feeds, supplies for feeding camp (drums, sakoline shed, waterer, etc.) and ropes.

PHILIPPINE ARMY

1. Standby Army Truck and manpower at Albay PDOC.
2. Conducted manpower assistance (pickup of 1 HP DesignJet) purposely for Mayon Volcano operation 2026 at Camp Simeon Ola, Daraga, Albay.

ALBAY PROVINCIAL POLICE OFFICE

1. Conduct evacuation assistance, police visibility operations and established WCPD help desk to ensure peace and order, prevent gender based violence and provide necessary police response and assistance to residents of Brgy Calbayog, Malilipot ,Brgy. Buhian and Brgy. Uson, Tabaco City.
2. Conducted foot patrol and intensified police presence at the border control point to ensure the safety and security of the residents in the affected area.
3. Conducted monitoring and Area Security at the Mayon Unit, Border Control Point, Brgy. Anoling, Camalig, Albay and Brgy. Mabinit.
4. Conducted dialogues and established WCPD helpdesk to ensure peace and order, prevent gender-based violence and provide necessary police response and assistance to residents of Brgy. Buang Tabaco City.
5. Conducted Red teaming/inspection to deployed personnel at BPC Sua, Quirangay, Anoling, Camalig, Albay and Buyoan, Legazpi City.
6. Assisted the delivery and distribution of 22 pcs of sleeping bag and hygiene kits from NGCP for residents of Brgy. Oson Tabaco City situated at San Antonio Evacuation Center Tabaco City.
7. Assisted the Philippine Red Cross during the distribution of 23 hygiene kit at Pawa Evacuation Center, Brgy. Pawa, Tabaco City, Albay.
8. Provided assistance during the distribution of 21 sleeping bags and hygiene kits from the National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) to the residents of Brgy. Buhian, Tabaco City, Albay.
9. Assisted the distribution of 337 food packs from PCSO Legazpi to evacuees of Brgy. Magapo Tabaco City situated at Hiraya Manawari Relocation, San Vicente Tabaco City.
10. Assisted the Department of Health (DOH) during the distribution of deworming chewable tablets in celebration of National Deworming Month to the evacuees of Brgy. Mariroc Sitio Nagsipit, Tabaco City, Albay.

5. Coordinate meeting with the Legazpi City Hospital regarding Disaster Preparedness and Management in Health for the Eruption of Mayon Volcano and distribution of two thousand (2,000) facemask.

CDRRMO LIGAO

1. Continuous update to barangays on the Mayon Volcano activity through group and phone messages.

MDRRMO DARAGA

1. Released Advisory No. 04-2026 reminding the public of the precautionary measures to be taken under this situation.
2. Continued geotagging the population at risk within the 9km Extended Danger Zone of Mayon Volcano.
