- DOST-PHIVOLCS recommends that the 6-km radius Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) be evacuated due to the danger of PDCs, lava flows, rockfalls and other volcanic hazards. Increased vigilance against pyroclastic density currents, lahars during heavy and prolonged rainfall and sediment-laden streamflows along channels draining the edifice is also advised. Civil aviation authorities must also advise pilots to avoid flying close to the volcano's summit as ash from any sudden eruption can be hazardous to aircraft. [PHIVOLCS]

APSEMO

January 1- 4, 2026

1. Issued PDRRMC Advisory No. 1 – implementing no human activity in the 6KM PDZ.
2. Maintained close coordination with PHIVOLCS.

January 5, 2026

1. Conducted emergency meeting with the PDRRMC response cluster for the execution of pre-emptive evacuation and coordinating arrangements for the response requirement.
2. Released updates and provided tri-media interviews for public awareness and information.
3. Continuous monitoring of Mayon Volcano status with Phivolcs.

January 6, 2026

1. Issued PDRRMC- Advisory No. 2 implementing pre-emptive evacuation of population inside the 6-kilometer radius permanent danger zone.
2. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
3. Conducted meeting with PNP, BFP, Phil. Army and PEO for the evacuation plan
4. Deployed the Phil. Army to LGU Tabaco for evacuation support.
5. Maintained continuous coordination with Office of Civil Defense V.
6. Consolidated situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.

January 7, 2026

1. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
2. Consolidated situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.
3. Attended Response Cluster meeting for Mayon conducted by OCD 5.
4. Submitted request to the Sanggunian Panlalawigan for a declaration of State of Calamity due to Mayon Volcano Eruption.
5. Provided interview with TV5 and other local media stations.
6. Continues monitoring with Phivolcs on Mayon Volcano status.

7. Deployed the 49th IB Phil. Army to LGU Guinobatan (3 KM 450 Truck), LGU Ligao (3 KM 450 Truck)
8. Deployed the 31st IB Phi. Army to LGU Malilipot (4 KM450 Tuck, 2KM250 Truck)
9. Deployed PEO (3 dump truck) to LGU Camalig to support evacuation.

January 8, 2026

1. Attended PDRRMC emergency meeting.
2. Coordinated with the National Food Authority for the availability of rice.
3. Coordinated with local social welfare officers to submit evacuation reports as basis for relief.
4. Prepositioned relief for augmentation to LGUs evacuated population

PROV'L ENGINEERING OFFICE

1. Provided 3 dump trucks and 3 personnel to support evacuation in Camalig, Albay.
2. Conducted inspection of evacuation centers to support utility requirements.
3. Provided dump truck to APSEMO to transport family tents to LGU Malilipot.

1. Established evacuation centers and ensured safety, sanitation and health monitoring for evacuees.

3. 31IB activity dtd 071630 - 080700 January 2026 1. On 071615 January 2026, one (1) pltn (-) of Alpha Coy led by 2LT JUAGPAO, Officer-in-Charge, together with Governor Noel E. Rosal, Governor of Albay conducted Distribution of food packs at San Jose Elementary School, Brgy. San Jose, Malilipot, Albay. Activity ended at about 1530 same day.
4. On 072340 January 2026, 1LT ALFREDO PENALES (INF) PA, Officer-in-Charge, Charlie Company, 31IB, 9ID, PA, conducted coordination with Mr. Gelacio M. Molato, Head, CDRRMO, Tabaco City, Albay, regarding the status of the ongoing evacuation of residents within the Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) of Mt. Mayon. The coordination was conducted at the CDRRMO Building, Tabaco City Central Terminal Compound, Pawa, Tabaco City, Albay. Activity ended at about 2355 same day.

PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE

1. Coordinated with Albay PDRRMC and committed personnel to support security in evacuation centers and barangays along the 6-km radius PDZ.

X. DOCUMENTATION

The APSEMO Research Team was pleased to accommodate the request from the University of the Philippines Los Baños (UPLB) PULSE Project team today.
A productive discussion was done for their research on climate cooling technologies which provides opportunities to explore potential collaboration in the province.



APSEMO, on behalf of the Provincial Government of Albay (PGA), distributed 4 family tents to the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Malilipot, Albay. The tents are intended to support displaced families affected by the current Alert Level 3 status of Mayon Volcano. The family tents were sourced from the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) Region 5. This initiative aims to provide temporary shelter to families who have been evacuated due to the volcanic activity.
