VII. ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN

APSEMO

1. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
2. Consolidate situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.
3. Provided interview with Bilyonaryo News Channel, Manila on Mayon update.
4. Distributed 2 sets of family tent and 10 sets tarp with rope from DSWD through OCD5.
5. Provided fuel (30) to Albay Veterinary Office for the Mayon operation on Livestock.

PROVINCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE

1. Coordinated with the National Food Authority for the availability of rice.
2. Coordinated with local social welfare officers to submit evacuation reports as basis for relief.
3. Submit consolidated dromic report - Mayon Operation to APSEMO.

PROV'L ENGINEERING OFFICE

1. Provided 3 dump trucks and 3 personnel to support evacuation in Camalig, Albay.
2. Conducted inspection of evacuation centers to support utility requirements.
3. Provided dump truck to APSEMO to transport family tents to LGU Malilipot.

PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE

1. Established evacuation centers and ensured safety, sanitation and health monitoring for evacuees.
2. Conducted continuous monitoring of situation and reporting of updates to APSEMO.
3. Emergency response teams activated and coordinated with local authorities.
4. Distributed Hygiene kits, face masks, soaps and other health-related commodities to identified evacuation centers.
5. The 24/7 Operation Center at the Provincial Health Office-Albay has been activated since January 06, 2026

PHILIPPINE ARMY

1. Coordinated with MDRRMO Guinobatan, MDRRMO Ligao and Albay PDRRMC for possible deployment.
2. Assist in the evacuation of affected population in Guinobatan and Ligao.
3. 31IB conducted Distribution of food packs at San Jose Elementary School, Brgy. San Jose, Malilipot, Albay.
4. 31IB, 9ID, PA, conducted coordination with Mr. Gelacio M. Molato, Head, CDRRMO, Tabaco City, Albay, re: status of the ongoing evacuation of residents within the 6KM PDZ. at the CDRRMO Building, Tabaco City .

ALBAY PROVINCIAL POLICE OFFICE

1. Coordinated with Albay PDRRMC and deployed personnel to support security in evacuation centers and barangays along the 6-km radius PDZ.
2. Malilipot MPS, Albay PPO, ACOP 1st Provincial Mobile Force Company, FC and 2nd Provincial Mobile Force Company, FC were deployed at aforementioned evacuation center to continuously conduct evacuation assistance, police visibility operations and stabilized WCPD helpdesk to ensure peace and order, prevent gender based violence and provide necessary police response and assistance to residents of Brgy Calbayog, Malilipot, Albay in relation to Alert Level 3 Status of Mayon Volcano.
3. Personnel of Guinobatan MPS conducted mobile patrol and monitoring of the residents near the 6KM danger Zone of Brgy Muladbucad Grande Guinobatan Albay.
4. Personnel of Albay 1st PMFC, together with personnel of Camalig MPS, conducted monitoring and Area Security at the Mayon Unit, Border Control Point, Brgy. Anoling, Camalig, Albay, in connection with the current Alert Level 3 status of Mayon Volcano to monitor the situation of families potentially affected by the volcanic activity.
5. Conducted monitoring and Area Security at the Mayon Unit, Border Control Point, Brgy. Bañadero Daraga, Albay, in connection with the current Alert Level 3 status of Mayon Volcano.
6. Augmented personnel from the 1st APMFC and RPSB were deployed to the evacuation center in Barangay Baligang, Ligao City and Tabaco City. They provided assistance to evacuees, maintained police visibility and presence, and established a Women and Children Protection Desk (WCPD) to ensure peace and order, prevent gender-based violence, and respond to the needs of residents
7. Conducted foot patrol and monitoring at the vacated areas, to ensure safety and security of residents within the affected area.
8. Conducted continuous monitoring operations and Distribution of Food Assistance to deployed personnel of this unit at Border Control Point, Brgy. Anoling Camalig, Albay, Purok 4, Brgy. Quirangay, Camalig, Albay, in connection with the current Alert Level 3 status of Mayon Volcano.
9. Assisted and provided police and security assistance during the distribution of 212 food Packs to the evacuees from Brgy Calbayog and 297 family food packs to the evacuees from Brgy. Calbayog and San Roque.

MDRRMO- CAMALIG

1. Dissemination of 2026 Mayon Volcano Evacuation Plan.
2. Evacuation Cluster Meeting conducted.
3. Evacuation of Families inside the 6km PDZ
4. Activated the EOC for Mayon Operations 2026 located at the 1st floor of Camalig Command Center.

5. Duty presence of MDRRMO Personnels at Various Evacuation Centers.
6. Relief Operations Conducted at Evacuation Centers with the Presence of DSWD Regional Director Norman S. Laurio and Mayor Carlos Irwin G. Baldo

MDRRMO - GUINOBATAN

1. Inform the LCE about the Mayon Status
2. Inventory of Evacuation centers, facilities and resources for possible massive evacuation
3. Recommend pre-positioning of goods.
4. Continuous coordination with BDRRMC and evaluation of families living outside the 6-km PDZ.
5. No entry on 6-km PDZ with PNP and Barangay Tanods detailed on the entry point
6. Information Dissemination on Mayon Volcano Alert Level
7. Continuous monitoring of weather updates.
8. Coordination meeting and pre-disaster risk assessment for Mayon Volcano 7km danger zone around Mayon Volcano and the barangays affected by shearline.
9. EOC activated and is placing cluster teams/ task force on standby status/Phil. Army in place for further instructions.

CDRRMO LEGAZPI

1. Continuous monitoring of updates from PHIVOLC and PAGASA through their website and other social media platforms.
2. Monitored CCTV live feed for possible flooding and incidents.
3. Continuous checkpoints to restrict entry to the 6km PDZ c/o Legazpi City Police Station
4. Provided food assistance to personnel manning the border control checkpoints At Barangay Buyoan and Mabinit c/o City Mayor's Office
5. Distributed facemasks to Barangay Padang, Buyoan, Matanag, Bogña and Padang c/o City Health Office
6. Conducted ocular inspection and rapid health assessment to pre-determined evacuation Centers c/o City Health Office.

CDRRMO TABACO

1. Established border control at barangay Buang going to Mayon Planetarium and at barangay Oson going to barangay Magapo
2. Conducted Evacuation of 5 barangays with in the 6km PDZ to together with other line Agencies
3. Provided tents to IDPs at Barangay Mariroc and Buang
4. Provided current Status of Evacuees to OCD and APSEMO and Media Partners
5. Conducted Situational Meeting with the members of CDRRMC
6. Close Coordination with Regional and National line agencies
7. Provided Status of evacuees to mainstream media via interview
8. Conducted monitoring of evacuation centers and providing needed resources to the evacuees
9. Installed Data Information Board in every evacuation center in Tabaco City
10. Coordinated with DSWD Region 5 in preparation for the arrival of Secretary of DSWD Rex Gatchalian together with Governor Noel Rosal, and Cong. Krisel Lagman
11. Conducted monitoring and inspection of Evacuation Centers
12. Forwarded request letter for additional equipment's for evacuation center
