XI. ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN

APSEMO

1. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
2. Continues monitoring of Mayon Volcano Status with Phivolcs.
3. Consolidate situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.
4. Maintained Mayon Eruption 2026 Joint Operation Center.

PROV'L ENGINEERING OFFICE

1. Standby Dump Truck and manpower at Albay PDOC.

PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE

1. The Operations Center (OpCen) hotline remains fully operational, with no calls or inquiries received for the reporting period.
2. The PHO Operations Center remains on 24/7 operational status, continuously manned by the Health Emergency Management Staff (HEMS) to ensure sustained monitoring, effective coordination, and timely response to any emerging health concerns related to the ongoing situation.
3. The Albay Provincial Health Office (PHO), through the Provincial Epidemiology Surveillance Unit (PESU), in coordination with the respective Municipal Epidemiology Surveillance Units (MESUs), continues close and regular monitoring of all identified evacuation centers to evaluate their current conditions and promptly respond to any health-related issues or concerns.
4. The Provincial Health Office's official Facebook page continues to serve as a key platform for the dissemination of health advisories, public information, and online health promotion materials, particularly those related to the ongoing activity of Mayon Volcano.
5. Conducted routine disaster response monitoring in evacuation centers throughout the Second and Third Districts due to the current alert status of Mayon Volcano.
6. Conducted Mental Health and Psychological Support (9MHPSS) Activity at Bariw Evacuation Center in Camalig, Albay.

PHILIPPINE ARMY

1. Standby Army Truck and manpower at Albay PDOC.
2. Conducted transportation and pick-up of 1,500 pcs of Food Packs at Malabog Warehouse to MDRRMO Camalig using one (1) KM 250 unit of the 31IB.
3. Conducted transportation and pick-up of 2,000 pcs of Family Food Packs at DSWD Warehouse, Brgy. Pawa, Legazpi City to MDRRMO Malilipot using one (1) KM 250 unit of the 31IB.
