The Mayon Volcano has present lava effusion w/ lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (2.2 km), and Mi-isi (1.3 km) gullies; The crater glow is fair (naked eye). The plume has 1000 meters above the crater; moderate emission; west drift. Volcano edifice is inflated. [PHIVOLCS]

#### **APSEMO**

5. Deployed one (1) KM250 Army Truck to provide transportation and manpower assistance in the loading and hauling of 616 Family Food Packs from MDRRMO Camalig to Malabog Warehouse, Brgy. Malabog, Daraga, Albay vice versa.

#### **PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE**

1. The Operations Center (OpCen) hotline remains fully operational, with no calls or inquiries received for the reporting period.
2. The PHO Operations Center remains on 24/7 operational status, continuously manned by the Health Emergency Management Staff (HEMS) to ensure sustained monitoring, effective coordination, and timely response to any emerging health concerns related to the ongoing situation.
3. The Albay Provincial Health Office (PHO), through the Provincial Epidemiology Surveillance

Unit (PESU), in coordination with the respective Municipal Epidemiology Surveillance Units (MESUs), continues close and regular monitoring of all identified evacuation centers to evaluate their current conditions and promptly respond to any health-related issues or concerns.

4. The Provincial Health Office's official Facebook page continues to serve as a key platform for the dissemination of health advisories, public information, and online health promotion materials, particularly those related to the ongoing activity of Mayon Volcano.

#### **PHILIPPINE ARMY**

1. Standby Army Truck and manpower at Albay PDOC.
2. Conducted transportation and manpower assistance in the loading and hauling of 616 Family Food Packs from MDRRMO Camalig to Malabog Warehouse, Brgy. Malabog, Daraga, Albay vice versa, utilizing one (1) KM250 truck unit of the (31IB) in coordination with the Camalig MSWDO.

#### **ALBAY PROVINCIAL POLICE OFFICE**

1. PLTCOL LARRY NIÑO PREPOTENTE, OIC Daraga MPS conducted an intensified Police Visibility/Presence operation in relation to the Alert Level Status of Mt. Mayon Volcano within the 6–7-kilometer Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) at Brgy. Bañadero, Daraga Albay
2. PMAJ DARWIN S SEVILLA, OIC, together with personnel of Albay Provincial Mobile Force Company manned the aforementioned BCP to continuously conduct police visibility operations to prevent unauthorized entry into the PDZ
3. PMFC conducted monitoring and Area Security at the Mayon Unit, Border Control Point, Brgy. Sua, Camalig, Albay,
4. Continuously conduct evacuation assistance, police visibility operations implementation of curfew and established WCPD help desk to ensure peace and order, prevent gender-based violence and provide necessary police response and assistance to residents of Brgy Calbayog, Malilipot, Albay.
5. Conducted inspection to the duty personnel of Daraga MPS and Augmented Personnel from 1st and 2nd APMFC of BCP Bañadero Brgy. Bañadero, Daraga Albay, with no untoward incident happened.

#### **MDRRMO GUINOBATAN**


1. Inform the LCE about the Mayon Status
