I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

DATE: March 02, 2026

SUMMARY OF 24HR OBSERVATION (12 AM yesterday to 12 AM today)

The Mayon Volcano has present lava effusion with lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (2.6 km) and Mi-isi (1.3 km) gullies, with minor strombolian activity and ash emissions; The crater glow is fair (naked eye). The plume reached 200 meters above the crater with moderate emission and southwest drift. Volcano edifice is inflated. [PHIVOLCS]

PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE

1. The Operations Center (OpCen) hotline remains fully operational, with no calls or inquiries received for the reporting period.
2. The PHO Operations Center remains on 24/7 operational status, continuously manned by the Health Emergency Management Staff (HEMS) to ensure sustained monitoring, effective coordination, and timely response to any emerging health concerns related to the ongoing situation.
3. The Albay Provincial Health Office (PHO), through the Provincial Epidemiology Surveillance Unit (PESU), in coordination with the respective Municipal Epidemiology Surveillance Units (MESUs), continues close and regular monitoring of all identified evacuation centers to evaluate their current conditions and promptly respond to any health-related issues or concerns.
4. The Provincial Health Office's official Facebook page continues to serve as a key platform for the dissemination of health advisories, public information, and online health promotion materials, particularly those related to the ongoing activity of Mayon Volcano.

PROVINCIAL POLICE OFFICE

1. Conducted foot patrol and intensified police presence at the border control point under the direct supervision of PLTCOL JOSEPH A. IMPERIAL, COP Guinobatan MPS.
2. Established border control point at Brgy. Mabinit, Brgy. Buyoan, under the supervision of PLTCOL DOMINGO B TAPEL JR together with Barangay Tanod's in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) and other government agencies,
3. Conducted monitoring and inspection at Border Control Point, Purok 5, Brgy. Lidong, and Purok 6, Brgy. Fidel Surtida, Sto. Domingo, Albay.
4. Conducted an intensified Police Visibility/Presence operation in relation to the Alert Level Status of Mt. Mayon Volcano within the 6-7-kilometer Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) at Brgy. Bañadero, Daraga Albay.
5. Conducted a Drone Patrol at BCP Bañadero, Daraga Albay and at Black Lava OP Brgy. Mabinit, Legazpi City Albay.

PHILIPPINE ARMY

1. Standby Army Truck and manpower at Albay PDOC.

MDRRMO GUINOBATAN

1. Inform the LCE about the Mayon Status.
2. Continuous coordination with BDRRMC and evaluation of families living outside the 6-km PDZ.
3. No entry on the 6-km PDZ with PNP and Barangay Tanods detailed on the entry point.
4. Information Dissemination on Mayon Volcano Alert Level.
5. Continuous monitoring of Mayon updates.
6. Monitoring of Mayon volcano air quality.
7. Phil. Army in place for further instructions.
8. On blue alert status and stand by alert.
