The Mayon Volcano has present lava effusion w/ lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (2.7 km), and Mi-isi (1.3 km) gullies; The crater glow is fair (naked eye). The plume has 750 meters above the crater; weak emission; West-Southwest and Southwest and Northwest drift. Volcano edifice is inflated. [PHIVOLCS]

APSEMO

1. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
2. Continues monitoring of Mayon Volcano Status with Phivolcs.
3. Consolidate situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.
4. Maintained Mayon Eruption 2026 Joint Operation Center.
5. Deployed three (3) KM250 Army Truck to provide transportation and manpower assistance in the loading and hauling of 480 Hygiene Kits and Elbow Tent from MDRRMO Malilipot to DSWD Warehouse, Brgy. Pawa, Legazpi City vice versa.

1. Standby Dump Truck and manpower at Albay PDOC.

PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE

1. The Operations Center (OpCen) hotline remains fully operational, with no calls or inquiries received for the reporting period.
2. The PHO Operations Center remains on 24/7 operational status, continuously manned by the Health Emergency Management Staff (HEMS) to ensure sustained monitoring, effective coordination, and timely response to any emerging health concerns related to the ongoing situation.
3. The Albay Provincial Health Office (PHO), through the Provincial Epidemiology Surveillance Unit (PESU), in coordination with the respective Municipal Epidemiology Surveillance Units (MESUs), continues close and regular monitoring of all identified evacuation centers to evaluate their current conditions and promptly respond to any health-related issues or concerns.
4. The Provincial Health Office's official Facebook page continues to serve as a key platform for the dissemination of health advisories, public information, and online health promotion materials, particularly those related to the ongoing activity of Mayon Volcano.

PHILIPPINE ARMY

1. Conducted transportation and manpower assistance in the loading and hauling of 480 Hygiene Kits and Elbow Tents from MDRRMO Malilipot to DSWD Warehouse, Brgy. Pawa, Legazpi City vice versa, utilizing three (3) KM250 truck unit of the (31IB) in coordination with the MDRRMO Malilipot.
2. Standby Army Truck and manpower at Albay PDOC.

ALBAY PROVINCIAL POLICE OFFICE

1. PCPT EDITO RAYMUND B TORRE, DCOP/OIC, continuously conduct evacuation assistance, dialogue, police visibility operations and established WCPD help desk to ensure peace and order, prevent gender-based violence and provide necessary police response and assistance to residents of Brgy Calbayog, Malilipot, Albay.
2. PLTCOL JOSEPH A. IMPERIAL, COP Guinobatan MPS, conducted foot patrol and intensified police presence at the Mayon Unit, Border Control Point, Brgy. Muladbucad Grande, Guinobatan, Albay to ensure the safety and security of residents within the affected area.
3. Conducted an intensified Police Visibility/Presence operation in relation to the Alert Level Status of Mt. Mayon Volcano within the 6–7-kilometer Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) at Brgy. Bañadero, Daraga Albay.
4. PLTCOL DOMINGO B TAPPEL JR together with Barangay Tanod's in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) and other government agencies, established border control point at Brgy. Mabinit (GC 51P WQ 78038 57798) to restrict entry and ensure public safety.
5. Inspected the border control point and monitored the situation of families potentially affected by the volcanic activity.
7. Conducted Red Teaming and inspection of deployed personnel at Barangay Control Points Canaway in relation to the Alert Level 3 status of Mayon Volcano.
8. Conducted a Drone Patrol at BCP Bañadero, Daraga Albay, Operated by Pat Frey S Guevarra, Drone Pilot, together with Pat Axl Ocbian, Co Pilot.
