## MAYON VOLCANO OPERATION ACTIVITY/MONITORING REPORT 58 - 2026

March 04, 2026 - 5:00 PM

### I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

DATE: March 04, 2026

#### SUMMARY OF 24HR OBSERVATION (12 AM yesterday to 12 AM today)

SULFUR DIOXIDE FLUX: **1,755** tonnes / day (03 March 2026)

The Mayon Volcano has lava effusion with lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (2.7 km) and Mi-isi (1.3 km) gullies, with minor strombolian activity and ash emissions; The crater glow is fair (naked eye). The plume reached 500 meters above the crater with moderate emission and west-southwest and southwest drift. Volcano edifice is inflated. [PHIVOLCS]

## **PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE**

1. The Operations Center (OpCen) hotline remains fully operational, with no calls or inquiries received for the reporting period.
2. The PHO Operations Center remains on 24/7 operational status, continuously manned by the Health Emergency Management Staff (HEMS) to ensure sustained monitoring, effective coordination, and timely response to any emerging health concerns related to the ongoing situation.
3. The Albay Provincial Health Office (PHO), through the Provincial Epidemiology Surveillance Unit (PESU), in coordination with the respective Municipal Epidemiology Surveillance Units (MESUs), continues close and regular monitoring of all identified evacuation centers to evaluate their current conditions and promptly respond to any health-related issues or concerns.
4. The Provincial Health Office's official Facebook page continues to serve as a key platform for the dissemination of health advisories, public information, and online health promotion materials, particularly those related to the ongoing activity of Mayon Volcano.

## **PROVINCIAL POLICE OFFICE**

1. Conducted Border Control Point Monitoring police visibility operations in Sto. Domingo, Albay.
2. Conducted monitoring and Area Security at the Mayon Unit, Border Control Point, Brgy. Baligang Ligao City and Brgy. Anoling, Camalig, Albay.
3. Conducted monitoring and inspection at Border Control Point, Brgy. Quirangay, Camalig, Albay.

## **PHILIPPINE ARMY**

1. Standby Army Truck and manpower at Albay PDOC.
2. Transported 225 pieces of medical kits from MDRRMO Camalig to Brgy. Tagaytay, and Brgy. Bariw Camalig, Albay using one (1) KM250 of the 31IB.

## **CDRRMO LIGAO**

1. Continuous updates to barangays on the Mayon Volcano updates and activity through group messages and phone calls.

## **MDRRMO GUINOBATAN**

1. Inform the LCE about the Mayon Status.
2. Continuous coordination with BDRRMC and evaluation of families living outside the 6-km PDZ.
3. No entry on the 6-km PDZ with PNP and Barangay Tanods detailed on the entry point.
4. Information Dissemination on Mayon Volcano Alert Level.
5. Continuous monitoring of Mayon updates.
6. Monitoring of Mayon volcano air quality.
7. Phil. Army in place for further instructions.
8. On blue alert status and stand by alert.
