Lava effusion w/ lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (3.1 km), and Mi-isi (1.3 km) gullies, with episodic minor strombolian activity and short-lived lava fountaining; The crater glow is fair (naked eye). The plume reaches 800 meters above the crater with moderate emission drifting from southeast and southwest. Volcano edifice is inflated. [PHIVOLCS]

V. ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN

APSEMO

1. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
2. Continues monitoring of Mayon Volcano Status with Phivolcs.
3. Consolidate situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.
4. Maintained Mayon Eruption 2026 Joint Operation Center.
5. Coordinated with the Philippine Army 31IB in the transportation of 471 pieces hygiene kits from MDRRMO MALILIPOT to DSWD Warehouse Brgy. Pawa, Legazpi City, Albay and vice versa.

6. Coordinated with the Philippine Army 31IB in the transportation of 205 pieces medical kits from DSWD warehouse Brgy. Pawa Legazpi City to Brgy. Tagaytay, and Brgy. Bariw, Camalig, Albay and vice versa.

PROVINCIAL POLICE OFFICE

1. Conduct evacuation assistance, police visibility operations and established WCPD help desk at Tent City Evacuation Center, San Jose Malilipot Albay and provide necessary police response and assistance to residents of Brgy Calbayog, Malilipot, Albay.
2. Conducted monitoring and Area Security at the Mayon Unit, Border Control Point, Brgy. Sua, Camalig, Albay.
3. Conducted a Drone Patrol at Brgy Mabinit, Legazpi City Albay.
4. Provided police presence and security during the distribution of water containers and cash assistance for hygiene kits to 112 families of Purok 7, Barangay Muladbudad Grande, Guinobatan, Albay. The items were donated by NGO Start Network.

PHILIPPINE ARMY

1. Transported 471 pieces hygiene kits from from MDRRMO MALILIPOT to DSWD Warehouse Brgy. Pawa, Legazpi City, Albay and vice versa using two (2) KM250 truck at 8:00 AM, March 13, 2026.
2. Transported 205 pieces medical kits from DSWD warehouse Brgy. Pawa Legazpi City to Brgy. Tagaytay, and Brgy. Bariw, Camalig, Albay and vice versa using one (1) KM250 truck at 1:00 PM, March 13, 2026.

PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE

1. The Operations Center (OpCen) hotline remains fully operational, with no calls or inquiries received for the reporting period.
2. The PHO Operations Center remains on 24/7 operational status, continuously manned by the Health Emergency Management Staff (HEMS) to ensure sustained monitoring, effective coordination, and timely response to any emerging health concerns related to the ongoing situation.
3. The Albay Provincial Health Office (PHO), through the Provincial Epidemiology Surveillance Unit (PESU), in coordination with the respective Municipal Epidemiology Surveillance Units (MESUs), continues close and regular monitoring of all identified evacuation centers to evaluate their current conditions and promptly respond to any health-related issues or concerns.
4. The Provincial Health Office's official Facebook page continues to serve as a key platform for the dissemination of health advisories, public information, and online health promotion materials, particularly those related to the ongoing activity of Mayon Volcano.

MDRRMO GUINOBATAN

1. Inform the LCE about the Mayon status.
2. Continuous coordination with BDRRMC and evaluation of families living outside the 6-km PDZ.
3. No entry on the 6-km PDZ with PNP and Barangay Tanods detailed on the entry point.
4. Information Dissemination on Mayon Volcano Alert Level.
5. Continuous monitoring of Mayon updates.

6. Monitoring of Mayon volcano air quality.
7. Phil. Army in place for further instructions.
8. On blue alert status and stand by alert.

CDRMO LIGAO

1. Constantly updates the barangays on the Mayon Volcano updates and activity through group messages and phone calls.
