Lava effusion w/ lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (3.2 km), and Mi-isi (1.3 km) gullies, with episodic minor strombolian activity; The crater glow is fair (naked eye). The plume is obscured. Volcano edifice is inflated. [PHIVOLCS]

#### **APSEMO**

1. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
2. Continues monitoring of Mayon Volcano Status with Phivolcs.
3. Consolidate situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.
4. Maintained Mayon Eruption 2026 Joint Operation Center.

#### **PROVINCIAL POLICE OFFICE**

1. Continuously conduct evacuation assistance, police visibility operations, Implementation of Curfew, and established WCPD help desk at Tent City Evacuation Center, San Jose Malilipot Albay.
2. Conducted an intensified Police Visibility/Presence operation in relation to the Alert Level Status of Mt. Mayon Volcano within the 6–7- kilometer Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) at Brgy. Bañadero, Daraga Albay.
3. Conducted an inspection of deployed personnel at the 6km Permanent Danger Zone Border Control Point and reminded to be vigilant at all times and always observe the proper wearing of uniform (tamang bihis).
4. Conducted a Drone Patrol at Black Lava OP Brgy. Mabinit, Legazpi City Albay.

5. Conduct evacuation assistance, dialogue, police visibility operations and established WCPD help-desk to ensure peace and order, prevent gender-based violence and Provide necessary police response to residents of Brgy. Magapo Tabaco City situated at Hiraya Manawari Relocation, San Vicente Tabaco City.
6. Conducted police visibility at the evacuation center as part of the outreach program of Tabaco National High School and Nursing Department of Cope College.

### **PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE**

1. The Operations Center (OpCen) hotline remains fully operational.
2. The Provincial Health Office's official Facebook page continues to serve as a key platform for the dissemination of health advisories, public information, and online health promotion materials, particularly those related to the ongoing activity of Mayon Volcano.
