I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Lava effusion w/ lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (3.2 km), and Mi-isi (1.3 km) gullies, with episodic minor strombolian activity and short-lived lava fountaining; The crater glow is fair (naked eye). The plume reaches 200 meters above the crater with moderate emission; west drift. Volcano edifice is inflated. [PHIVOLCS]

APSEMO

1. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
2. Continues monitoring of Mayon Volcano Status with Phivolcs.
3. Consolidate situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.
4. Maintained Mayon Eruption 2026 Joint Operation Center.

PROVINCIAL POLICE OFFICE

1. Established border control point at Brgy. Mabinit and at Brgy. Buyuan under the supervision of PLTCOL DOMINGO B TAPPEL JR together with Barangay Tanod's in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) and other government agencies.
2. Border Control Point in Brgy. San Roque and Brgy. Calbayog Malilipot to monitor Mayon Volcano and ensure the enforcement of safety protocols, maintain peace and order, and assist residents within the 6-kilometer Permanent Danger Zone under Alert Level 3.
3. Conducted an intensified Police Visibility/Presence operation in relation to the Alert Level Status of Mt. Mayon Volcano within the 6-7- kilometer Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) at Brgy. Bañadero, Daraga Albay.
4. Conducted monitoring and inspection of firearms and ammunitions of deployed

personnel at Border Control Point, in connection with the current Alert Level 3 status of Mayon Volcano.

5. Continuously conduct evacuation assistance, police visibility operations and established WCPD helpdesk to ensure peace and order, prevent gender base violence and provide necessary police response and assistance to residents of Brgy. Buang Tabaco City.

PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE

1. The Operations Center (OpCen) hotline remains fully operational.
2. The Provincial Health Office's official Facebook page continues to serve as a key platform for the dissemination of health advisories, public information, and online health promotion materials, particularly those related to the ongoing activity of Mayon Volcano.
