Lava effusion w/ lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (3.2 km), and Mi-isi (1.3 km) gullies, with episodic minor strombolian activity and short-lived lava fountaining; The crater glow is fair (naked eye). The plume reaches 100 meters above the crater with moderate emission; Southwest, south and west-southwest drift. [PHIVOLCS]

#### **APSEMO**

1. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
2. Continues monitoring of Mayon Volcano Status with Phivolcs.
3. Consolidate situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.
4. Maintained Mayon Eruption 2026 Joint Operation Center.

#### **PROVINCIAL POLICE OFFICE**

1. PLTCOL LARRY NIÑO PREPOTENTE, OIC Daraga MPS conducted an intensified Police Visibility/Presence operation in relation to the Alert Level Status of Mt. Mayon Volcano within the 6–7-kilometer Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) at Brgy. Bañadero, Daraga Albay. The activity aims to prevent unauthorized entry into the PDZ, ensure public safety, and provide necessary police response and assistance. The operation is currently ongoing.
2. PLTCOL ARTHUR C TAGTAG JR together with Barangay Tanod's in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) and other Government Agencies, established border control point at Brgy. Buyoan ( GC: 51P WQ 80214 59978) to restrict entry and ensure public safety.
3. PLTCOL ARTHUR C TAGTAG JR together with Barangay Tanod's in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) and other government agencies, established border control point at Brgy. Mabinit (GC 51P WQ 78038 57798) to restrict entry and ensure public safety.
4. PMAJ DARWIN S SEVILLA, COP, together with personnel of 1ST Provincial Mobile Force Company manned the aforementioned BCP to continuously conducted Border Control Point Monitoring police visibility operations to prevent entry/exit in high-risk areas, and ensure public safety in connection with Mayon Volcano Alert Level 3. The operation is currently ongoing.

5. PLTCOL DANNY B BAYTEC, OIC Ligao CPS conducted monitoring and Area Security at the Mayon Unit, Border Control Point, Brgy. Baligang Ligao City Albay, in connection with the current Alert Level 3 status of Mayon Volcano to monitored the situation of families potentially affected by the volcanic activity.

6. Monitoring of Mayon volcano air quality.
7. Phil. Army in place for further instructions.
8. On blue alert status and stand by alert.

### **CDRRMO LIGAO**

1. Constantly updates the barangays on the Mayon Volcano updates and activity through group messages and phone calls.
