I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

DATE: March 23, 2026

VOLCANIC EARTHQUAKES: **128 including 12 volcanic tremors (16-62 minutes)**

SULFUR DIOXIDE FLUX: **1,971 tonnes / day (22 March 2026)**

Lava effusion w/ lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (3.2 km), and Mi-isi (1.3 km) gullies, with episodic minor strombolian activity and short-lived lava fountaining; The crater glow is fair (naked eye). The plume reaches 100 meters above the crater with moderate emission; north-northwest, west and northwest drift. Volcano edifice is inflated. [PHIVOLCS]

APSEMO

1. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
2. Continues monitoring of Mayon Volcano Status with Phivolcs.
3. Consolidate situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.
4. Maintained Mayon Eruption 2026 Joint Operation Center.
5. Coordinated with the Philippine Army 31IB to transport of 2000 pcs. food packs from MDRRMO Malilipot to DSWD warehouse Brgy. Pawa, Legazpi City Albay using three (3) KM 250.

PROVINCIAL POLICE OFFICE

1. Conducted an evacuation assistance, dialogue, police visibility operations and established WCPD help desk to ensure peace and order, prevent gender-based violence and provide necessary police response and assistance to residents of Brgy Calbayog, Malilipot, Albay.
2. Conducted an intensified Police Visibility/Presence operation at Brgy. Baligang Ligao City Albay to prevent unauthorized entry into the PDZ, ensure public safety, and provide necessary police response and assistance.
3. Provided necessary police assistance and security during the conduct of Relief Distribution of groceries at San Antonio Evacuation Center from ABS CBN

Foundation Sagip Kapamilya to 22 affected families from Brgy. OSON, Tabaco City, Albay.

4. Provide assistance during the relief distribution of DSWD food packs to the IDP's of Brgy. Anoling, Camalig, Albay at Tagaytay Elementary School. Likewise, conducted police visibility operations within the area to ensure peace and order and be able to provide necessary police assistance.
5. Established border control point at Brgy. Mabinit under the supervision of PLTCOL ARTHUR C TAGTAG JR together with Barangay Tanod's in coordination with the Local Government Unit (LGU) and other government agencies.
6. Provided assistance during the relief distribution of ABS CBN Foundation to 123 families of Brgy. Anoling, Camalig, Albay at Tagaytay Elementary School, Brgy. Tagaytay, Camalig, Albay.

PHILIPPINE ARMY

1. Transported 2000 pcs. food packs from MDRRMO Malilipot to DSWD warehouse Brgy. Pawa, Legazpi City Albay using (3) KM 250.

PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE

4. Information Dissemination on Mayon Volcano Alert Level.
5. Continuous monitoring of Mayon updates.
6. Monitoring of Mayon volcano air quality.
7. Phil. Army in place for further instructions.
8. On blue alert status and stand by alert.
