I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

DATE: March 31, 2026

SUMMARY OF 24HR OBSERVATION (12 AM yesterday to 12 AM today)

ALERT LEVEL STATUS: **3**
VOLCANIC EARTHQUAKES: **208** (incl. 19 volcanic tremors lasting for 1-8 minutes)
ROCKFALL EVENTS: **165**
PYROCLASTIC DENSITY CURRENT (PDC): **2**
SULFUR DIOXIDE FLUX: **3,550** tonnes / day (30 March 2026)

Lava effusion with lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (3.2 km), and Mi-isi (1.3 km) gullies, with episodic minor strombolian activity and short-lived lava fountaining; The crater glow is fair (naked eye). The plume reaches 500 meters above the crater with moderate emission in southwest drift. Volcano edifice is inflated. [PHIVOLCS]
