I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

DATE: April 23, 2026

SUMMARY OF 24HR OBSERVATION (12 AM yesterday to 12 AM today)

ALERT LEVEL STATUS: **3**
VOLCANIC EARTHQUAKES: **47 including 26 volcanic tremors (1-80 minutes)**
ROCKFALL EVENTS: **223**
PYROCLASTIC DENSITY CURRENT (PDC): **2**
SULFUR DIOXIDE FLUX: **1,008 tonnes / day (22 April 2026)**

Lava effusion with lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (3.2 km), and Mi-isi (1.3 km) gullies, with episodic minor strombolian activity and short-lived lava fountaining; The crater glow is fair (naked eye). The plume reaches 1000 meters above the crater with moderate emission in west-northwest, west, and west-southwest drift. Volcano edifice has short-term deflation with shorter-term inflation on the northeastern flank. [PHIVOLCS]

6. Monitoring of Mayon volcano air quality.
7. Phil. Army in place for further instructions.
8. On blue alert status and stand by alert.

CDRRMO LIGAO

1. The CDRRMO constantly updates the barangays on the Mayon Volcano updates and activity through group messages and phone calls.
