I. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

DATE: June 01, 2026

SUMMARY OF 24HR OBSERVATION (12 AM yesterday to 12 AM today)

ALERT LEVEL STATUS: **3**
VOLCANIC EARTHQUAKES: **24 including 9 volcanic tremors (2-48 minutes)**
ROCKFALL EVENTS: **311**
PYROCLASTIC DENSITY CURRENT (PDC): **2**
SULFUR DIOXIDE FLUX: **1,638 tonnes / day (31 May 2026)**

Lava effusion with lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (3.2 km), and Mi-isi (1.8 km) gullies, with minor strombolian activity; The crater glow is fair (naked eye). The plume has moderate emission in east-southeast, northeast, and east-northeast drift. It has short-term deflation of the edifice with shorter-term inflation on the northeastern flank [PHIVOLCS]
