Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms due to Southwest Monsoon will be experienced over Oriental Mindoro and Camarines Norte.

Flash floods or landslides are possible due to moderate to at times heavy rains. Meanwhile, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms also due to Southwest Monsoon are expected over the rest of Bicol Region. Flash floods or landslides are possible during severe thunderstorms. Moderate to strong winds from the Southwest will prevail and the coastal waters will be moderate to rough. [DOST-PAGASA]

IX. ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN

APSEMO

1. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
2. Conducted pre-disaster activities and inventories ensuring that mitigation measures are in place to maintain zero casualty and minimize damage to properties.
3. Consolidate situational reports from the LGU’s and response clusters.
4. Released updates and provided media interview for public awareness and information.
5. Maintained close coordination and monitoring with PAGASA for the latest weather update.

CDRRMO LEGAZPI CITY

1. Disseminated safety precautions, weather bulletins, and other related information (e.g Heavy Rainfall Warnings) through the Legazpi City DRRMO’s Facebook Page.
2. Monitored Tandem Stations (Dita and San Francisco) and AWS for rainfall events.
3. Recorded hourly rainfall volume.
4. Continuous monitoring of updates from PHIVOLCS and PAGASA through their website and other social media platforms.
5. Monitored CCTV live feed for possible flooding and incidents.
6. Maintained close coordination and monitoring with PAGASA for the latest weather update.
