Lava flow on Basud (3.8 km), Bonga (3.2 km), and Mi-isi (2.7 km) gullies; The crater glow is fair (naked eye). The plume is obscured. It has inflation of the edifice with short-term deflation on the northeastern flank. [PHIVOLCS]

APSEMO

- 1. Released PDRPMC-APSEMO ADVISORY- 2026 – 13.
- 2. Maintained 24-hour PDOC operation and monitoring.
- 3. Consolidate situational reports from the LGU's and response clusters.
- 4. Released updates for public awareness and information.
- 5. Continuous monitoring with PHIVOLCS on Mayon Volcano status.

PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICE

- 1. Continuous monitoring with PHIVOLCS on Mayon Volcano status.
- 2. Distributed medicines and medical supplies which includes the following:
  - two (2) units of nebulizer, compressor, heavy duty
  - two (2) units of BP Aneroid w/ Stethoscope (Adult)
  - one (1) unit of BP Digital arm w/ adaptor
  - one (1) unit of thermometer, thermal scanner
  - one (1) unit of Pulse oximeter (Adult) with batteryTo LGUs (Tabaco City, and Daraga) CHO/RHU affected by the Mayon Volcanic unrest under the State of Emergency.
- 3. The Provincial Health Office’s official Facebook page continues to serve as a key platform for the dissemination of health advisories, public information, and online health promotion materials, particularly those related to the ongoing activity of Mayon Volcano

MDRRMO GUINOBATAN

- 1. Inform the LCE about the Mayon Status
- 2. Continuous coordination with BDRPMC and evaluation of families living outside the 6-km PDZ.
- 3. No entry on the 6-km PDZ with PNP and Barangay Tanods detailed on the entry point.
- 4. Information Dissemination on Mayon Volcano Alert Level.
- 5. Continuous monitoring of Mayon updates.
- 6. Monitoring of Mayon volcano air quality
- 7. Phil. Army in place for further instructions.
- 8. On blue alert status and stand by alert.
- 9. Guinobatan is under the State of Calamity based on the resolution approved by the Sangguniang Bayan.
- 10. DOST-PHIVOLCS is lowering the Alert Level of Mayon Volcano from Alert Level 3 (magmatic unrest / increased tendency towards hazardous eruption) to Alert Level 2 (moderate level of unrest).
- 11. Still on monitoring status despite the notice for the lowering of Mayon Volcano’s status from Alert Level 3 (magmatic unrest / increased tendency towards hazardous eruption) to Alert Level 2 (moderate level of unrest).

- 12. Strict compliance to MDRRMC Advisory No. 8, s. 2026 - MAYON ALERT LEVEL 2.
- 13. Assistance provided/distributed to farmers affected by the ashfall in the Municipality.
