DECAMPMENT (Mayon Volcano Eruption)

August 5, 2026

5:00 P.M.

With the lowering of the Alert Level Status of Mayon Volcano from **Alert Level 3** to **Alert Level 2** based on Mayon Volcano Bulletin dated August 5, 2026 at 3:00 P.M. the respective LGU's are directed as follows :

1. **DECAMPMENT** of evacuated population to commence tomorrow August 6, 2026 at 8:00 AM. provided that C/MDRRMOs inspect and certify that it is safe for them to return to the community.
2. The LGU's concerned will facilitate the decampment and clean-up of the temporary shelters used.
3. Mayon Volcano remains under Alert Level 2 (Moderate Level of Unrest) and is still considered restless, the General Public are advised of the following:
 - ❖ Strictly No Entry into the 6-kilometer Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ).
 - ❖ Communities near the Mi-isi, Bonga, and Basud gullies are advised to remain vigilant for possible lahars and sediment-laden stream flows during heavy or prolonged rainfall.
 - ❖ Pilots are advised to avoid flying close to the volcano's summit due to the potential danger from sudden ash emissions or other volcanic hazards.
 - ❖ The public is advised to stay vigilant, monitor official advisories from DOST-PHIVOLCS, PDRRMC, APSEMO, and other government authorities, and continue to prioritize safety at all times.
4. All city/municipal and barangay DRRMCs are advised to be vigilant in their respective areas and to remain alert and standby for official updates and further advisories from PHIVOLCS and local authorities.
